The Preliminary Visit is carried out with the following objectives: Identify the areas to be audited during the initial assessment Provide a basis for preparing the audit programme Decide on the requirements part of ISO 3834 Report on the Document Review if already carried out Identify the normative standards used by the manufacturer Review current welding practices and assess their potential compliance with ISO 3834
